

## League Rules

**\*\*NOTE:** All league rulings will be at the discretion of the BCCSL Commissioners.

- Game Rules

- a. NCAA rules apply to all games. Pitch clock and time between innings will be enforced.
- b. Wood bats will be used for all games. BBCOR bats will not be permitted.
- c. Each game is scheduled to be 9 innings. Ties will be permitted if both teams have scored the same amount of runs after 9 full innings.
- d. Teams are allowed to hit 10 players in a lineup. One Designated Hitter (DH) and one Extra Hitter (EH).
- e. EH cannot come into pitch, but can be used to play defense as long as the lineup stays the same. Once a player is replaced in the lineup or is replaced on defense, he is out of the game and the new player is now in the game.

- f. All playoff and championship games will be 9 inning games with no California Tie Breaker in the case of a tie after 9 innings.
- g. All league games must use league issued Rawlings baseballs.
- h. Weather permitting, all games will be played on the date and time that is scheduled. All makeup games will be TBD.
- i. Home team is responsible for keeping a scorebook (GameChanger) and report stats to league officials after the conclusion of each game.
- League Standings
  - a. Top 4 teams will make the playoffs. #1 seed will play #4 seed in Playoff Game 1. #2 seed will play #3 seed in Playoff Game 2. Winners of each of those games will play each other in a best 2 out of 3 Championship Series.
  - b. Tiebreakers: if two teams are tied with the same record at the completion of all league games, head to head record will be used to break the tie. If head to head is tied after the regular season, the second tiebreaker will be runs allowed. If runs allowed is tied after

the regular season, runs scored will be the third tiebreaker.
